

## Are you eligible for StraffordCare?

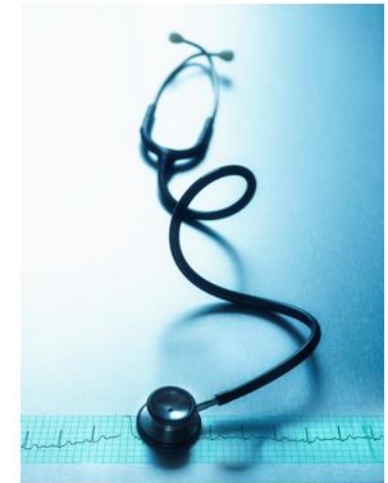
- You must live in Strafford County, NH.
- You must be under the age of 64.
- You must meet the income guidelines of the current federal poverty level guidelines.
- You must have an established primary care physician. If you do not have one, an a new patient appointment will be scheduled with a primary care physician who is accepting new patients.
- You must not be eligible for existing services such as NH Medicaid or Medicare. NH Medicaid application assistance is available.

## What is StraffordCare?

- StraffordCare is a comprehensive network of hospitals and primary, specialty and ancillary health care providers generously offering their services to the uninsured at a reduced cost.
- StraffordCare links you to a Care Coordinator at Avis Goodwin Community Health Center who will connect you to needed services.
- The Care Coordinator will work with your primary care provider to make the appropriate links to specialty and ancillary services that you need.
- StraffordCare does not replace existing programs in your community, it compliments it.



## How does StraffordCare Operate?

- Call StraffordCare to set up an appointment with a Care Coordinator.
- If you do not currently have a primary care physician, the Care Coordinator will connect you with one.
- If eligible, you will be presented with a StraffordCare enrollment card.
- Discounted patient fees and participating providers will be explained to you by your Care Coordinator.
- You will present the enrollment card at the time of service and pay agreed upon fee directly to the provider office.
- Enrollment cards are valid for one year. A month prior to expiration re-enrollment forms will be mailed to you.

## Your Care Coordinator

- Will work directly with you to answer any questions or resolve any concerns that you may have.
- Will provide referrals to as many resources as available.
- Will help you recognize your strengths and maximize your use of health and support services in the community.
