

Benefits of StraffordCare?

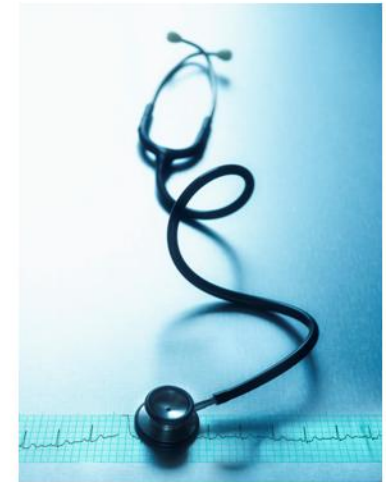
- You decide the number of eligible participants for your practice. You may enroll your established patients who meet our guidelines.

What is StraffordCare?

- StaffordCare is not insurance; it is a comprehensive network of primary, specialty and ancillary health care providers generously offering their services to the uninsured at a reduced fee.
- StaffordCare will link participants to a Care Coordinator at Avis Goodwin Community Health Center. The Care Coordinator works with primary care providers to make the appropriate links to specialty and ancillary services for the participant.
- StaffordCare doesn't replace existing programs, it compliments it.
- StaffordCare will increase access to healthcare and existing community resources for uninsured residents of Strafford County, NH.
- StaffordCare supports appropriate utilization of healthcare services and improved health status outcomes of participants.

How Does StraffordCare Operate?

- Participants will call StraffordCare directly to set up an appointment with a Care Coordinator.
- If the participant does not have a primary care physician, the Care Coordinator will connect him/her with one.
- Eligibility requirements considered for enrollment are: Participant must be a resident of Strafford County, must be under the age of 65, must not be eligible for NH Medicaid or Medicare, must have an established primary care physician and must be verified to be below 200% of poverty.



How Does StraffordCare Operate?

- Once eligible, the participant will receive a StraffordCare enrollment card.
- The participant will present the card at the time of service and pay the agreed upon fee directly to you.
- Services provided at your office will be communicated to StraffordCare via a medical claim form.
- Together, we can reduce costs and redirect savings to cover more uninsured residents of Strafford County.
